SEMINAR OVERVIEW

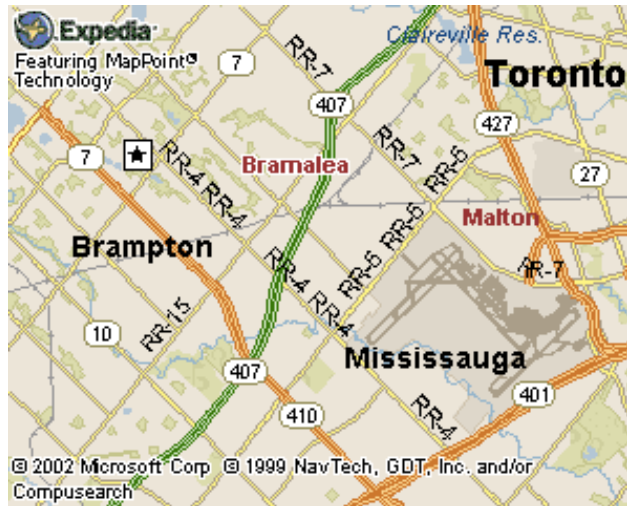
