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Offences

- · Child abuse requires report to CAS
- Concealment of an offence may itself be an offence
- Property damage is usually a police matter
- Theft and fraud offences are costly in terms of losses and require careful analysis
- Financial and other controls should be in place to reduce incidents of theft and fraud

• External frauds usually require police involvement

- Internal frauds may have negative impact if publicized
- Determine if to proceed in house or contact police. If police contact, complete cooperation required

Sexual Offences

- When information received about a possible sexual offence, exercise caution
- Remove possible offender from contact with complainant (s)
- Quickly and quietly investigate the complaint
- · Contact investigatory authorities
- Silence is more than golden
- Multiple proceedings create numerous problems

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Conclusions

- Remove possible offender from affected situation
- Delay internal proceedings
- Accountability and restoration should be end result
